

Instructions for applying for Carnet

1. Carnet can be issued only to a Life Member of the Automobile Association.
2. The vehicle should be in the name of the person applying for Carnet.
3. Carnet is not transferable.
4. The vehicle has to be produced for inspection at the time of applying for Carnet.
5. The vehicle owner who apply for the carnet only can drive the vehicle abroad. He should hold an International Driving Licence.
6. The Carnet is valid for one year and normally extension is not given. If in exceptional cases extension is sought, it will be given only for 6 months provided the issuing association is satisfied that it is necessary.
7. Bank Guarantee for 3 ½ times the original invoice value of the vehicle has to be given which will be returned only if the vehicle is brought back within the period of Carnet. Vehicle has to be shown at the time of surrender of Carnet.
8. The holder of the Carnet should ensure that the entry and exit is clearly marked and matched at the customs point so as to avoid customs demanding duty later.
9. The Fees for Carnet is Rs.1 lakh.
10. The Declaration, copy of R.C, Insurance and Emission Certificate along with Bank Guarantee and Application should be given with the necessary fees.
11. The original R.C and Insurance and Emission Certificate should be also shown.
12. The list of tools and equipments and other extra fittings to be taken with the vehicle should be listed and given along with application in duplicate.
